The Keynotes Music Scholarship Competition is available to students with exceptional musical talent. Auditions will be held on May 18, 2019, in the Fine Arts Theater of Mt. Lebanon High School.

A total of \$10,000.00 in cash awards will be made at the judge's discretion.

<u>First Place</u>	\$5,000.00
<u>Second Place</u>	\$3,000.00
<u>Third Place</u>	\$2,000.00

. Cash Awards will be paid to the winners the the day after the competition at a Brunch held in their honor at The LeMont Restaurant in Mt. Washington.

. An awardee becomes ineligible for subsequent competition after winning first place.

. 2019 competition contestants may be invited to perform at a Keynote function during the 2019-2020 year. They will be paid for their performance.

. Applicants must have maintained legal residence in Allegheny or Washington Counties or surrounding counties, in Pennsylvania for one year.

. A photocopy of voters ID, current driver's license, or similar document must be included with the application as proof of legal residence and age for first time applicants.

. Applicants must be full-time music majors currently enrolled at a music school or in the music department of a college or university. Graduating high school students are eligible if they have been accepted for admission and will enroll as full-time music students in the fall of 2019.

. Instrumentalists must be under 26 years of age by June 1, 2019.  
Vocalists must be under 30.

. A brief recommendation from the applicants' current music instructor is required only by first time applicants. The teacher may mail it separately to the Scholarship Chairman, postmarked by April 30, 2019.

Auditions will be held on Saturday, May 18, 2019 in the Fine Arts Theater of Mt. Lebanon High School, Cochran Road, MT. Lebanon, PA. Applications must be postmarked by April 30, 2019. Because we are restricted to twenty contestants and have had waiting lists in recent years, we strongly urge you to return the complete application package as early as possible, as we operate on a first come, first serve basis.

1. For the audition , you will be expected to perform one selection representative of each of these Periods: Baroque (1600-1750), Classical (1750-1820), Romantic (1820-1920), and 20<sup>th</sup> Century (1900-Present). This is your responsibility to make sure your music is in each of these periods.
2. Vocalists must include at least two different foreign language selections.
3. Applicants must provide their own accompanist.
4. Each applicant will be allotted fifteen minutes for the audition.

Performers /accompanists will be expected to appear and perform in appropriate dress attire Boys (Dress slacks and dress shirts, Girls- Long skirts, dresses or dress slacks, no bare midriffs.).

5. Memorization is preferred for audition selections.
